

Requirements for Low-Voltage Complete Sets of Equipment



Article Overview

Low-voltage complete sets of equipment must comply with the EU Low Voltage Directive (2014/35/EU) and relevant IEC standards, including IEC 62368-1, with additional guidance from SIST HD 60364 for overcurrent protection and prosumer installations.

Regulatory Framework

The Low Voltage Directive (LVD 2014/35/EU) applies to electrical equipment with AC voltages between 50V and 1000V and DC voltages between 75V and 1500V. It sets essential safety requirements to protect users from electrical hazards, including electric shock, fire, and mechanical risks. Compliance with the LVD is demonstrated by affixing the CE marking on the product, which indicates conformity with EU safety standards and harmonized technical specifications (Power-Sonic) .

Key Standards

- IEC 62368-1: This standard supersedes IEC 60950-1 (ICT equipment) and IEC 60065 (AV equipment) and introduces hazard-based safety engineering principles. It covers audio-visual, information, and communication technology equipment, ensuring protection against electrical, thermal, and mechanical hazards (Power-Sonic) .
- SIST HD 60364-4-43:2023/oprAA:2025: Focuses on overcurrent protection in low-voltage installations. It specifies techniques for protecting live conductors, automatic disconnection of supply in case of overload or short-circuit, and proper placement of protective devices, including neutral conductor protection in harmonics-prone environments (ITEH) .
