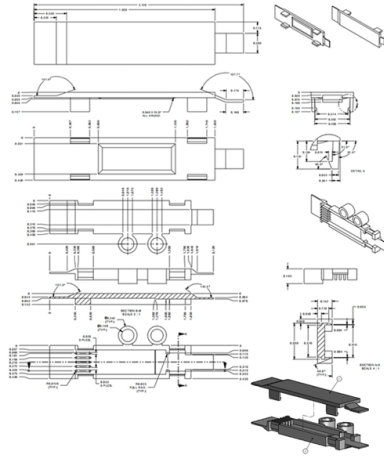


Requirements for Optical Cable Opening Operations



Article Overview

Proper optical cable opening operations require adherence to handling, safety, and installation standards to prevent fiber damage and ensure reliable network performance.

Cable Handling and Installation Guidelines

Bend Radius and Tension: Always respect the minimum bend radius specified by the manufacturer. For loose tube and ribbon cables, the bend radius should be at least 20 times the cable diameter during installation and 10 times during static conditions. Exceeding these limits can deform the cable core and increase attenuation.

Pulling tension must not exceed the maximum rated tensile force, typically around 600 lbf for OSP cables, and cable breakaway devices should be used to prevent overloading .

Cable Pulling and Jetting: Use swivels to prevent cable twist during pulling. When using cable jetting or blowing methods, ensure ducts are properly prepared with sufficient clearance and smooth entry/exit points. Lubricants may be applied to reduce friction, but spilled lubricant must be cleaned to prevent slips .

Reel and Equipment Handling: Reels must be lifted and moved using proper equipment, keeping forks perpendicular and avoiding drops. The reel should be positioned to minimize sharp bends at the first and last pulleys. Cable end caps or seals are recommended to protect the cable from contamination or air pressure during installation .
