

Requirements for drilling holes in electrical distribution boxes

Drilling holes in electrical distribution boxes is allowed only when following manufacturer instructions, safety precautions, and applicable electrical codes, with attention to material type and location.

General Guidelines

- Check Manufacturer Approval and NEC Compliance According to the National Electrical Code (NEC) Article 314, outlet, device, and junction boxes must maintain their original configuration unless the manufacturer specifically approves modifications. Most manufacturers do not allow drilling through the sides or back of standard boxes, as this can compromise safety and enclosure ratings . Always verify the box type and manufacturer instructions before drilling.
- Material Considerations
 - Plastic boxes: Use drill bits designed for plastic to avoid cracking or melting. Spritzing with water can help prevent overheating .
 - Metal boxes: Use metal-specific drill bits or step drills. Avoid twist drills in thin metal, as they can grab and distort the material .
 - Weatherproof or explosion-proof boxes: Special care is required. Explosion-proof boxes can be drilled, but only with proper drill bits, controlled speed, and protective measures to avoid damaging internal components .
- Safety Precautions
 - Turn off power to the circuit before drilling .
