

Requirements for the location of outdoor distribution boxes



Article Overview

Outdoor distribution boxes must be installed in accessible, dry, and weather-protected locations, at proper heights, with compliance to NEC and NEMA/IP standards.

Location and Environmental Considerations

Outdoor distribution boxes should be installed in dry, ventilated areas, away from flammable, corrosive, or explosive substances, and in locations that allow easy maintenance and inspection . The enclosure must be weatherproof, typically rated NEMA 3R or higher for rain-tight protection, with upgrades to NEMA 4X in coastal, chemical, or agricultural environments . IP-rated enclosures can be used internationally, but they are not exact equivalents to NEMA ratings . Avoid recessed mounting outdoors; surface mounting is preferred to maintain weatherproof integrity .

Height and Accessibility

For wall-mounted outdoor boxes, the recommended height is 4.5 to 5.5 feet (1.4 to 1.7 meters) to ensure accessibility without excessive bending or stretching . Outdoor boxes should be at least 3 feet above ground to protect against water, dirt, and accidental impacts . Ground-mounted boxes should be raised 2 to 4 inches to prevent moisture damage . Placement should also allow sufficient clearance for door operation and wire bending, following NEC 312.9 requirements .
