

Requirements for underground buried optical cables



Overview

Requirements vary based on location, cable type, and local regulations, with depths typically ranging from 18 to 48 inches. Residential areas require depths between 24 and 36 inches for most installations. 2 meters (3-4 feet) deep to reduce the likelihood of accidentally being dug up. In extreme cold climates, cables may need to be buried at greater depths where there temperatures are colder and frost penetrates to. The depth at which fiber optic cables are buried directly impacts their protection from damage and environmental factors.
