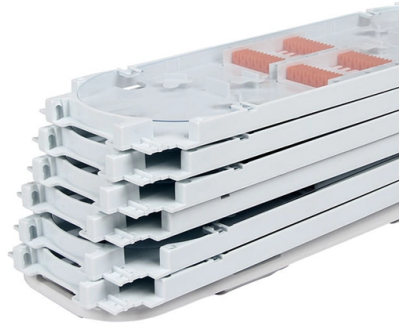


Revit cable tray connection tee



Article Overview

In Revit, a cable tray tee fitting requires three connectors and can be created manually or programmatically, with options to download pre-made families for modeling.

Manual Tee Connection

To connect cable trays in a tee configuration in Revit:

- **Use the Tee Fitting:** Revit's cable tray system requires a tee fitting to connect three tray segments. Each tee has three connectors—one for the main run and two for the branch—so a branch-only fitting cannot replace a tee directly .
- **Adjusting Type Properties:** You cannot simply swap a branch family into a tee because the tee needs three connectors. To mimic a branch fitting, you could modify a tee family visually while keeping three connectors, or start a new unconnected tray run at the branch location .
- **Orientation:** When placing manually, Revit automatically aligns the trays and adds the appropriate fittings. Ensure the connectors are properly oriented to match the main and branch trays .

Programmatic Creation

For automation or API use:

- **Connector Management:** Each cable tray segment has connectors accessible via `cableTray.ConnectorManager.Connectors`.
