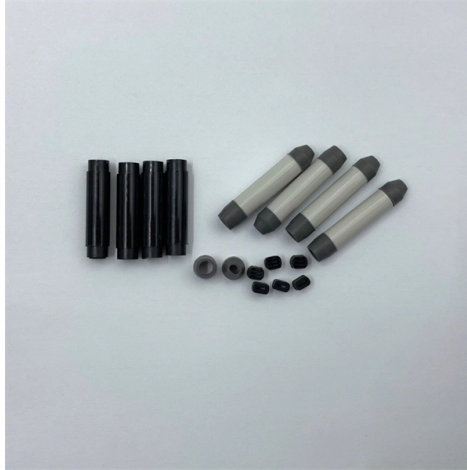


Roof cable tray support fixing distance

Mark the support, fix the threaded rod supports with appropriate metal plugs, and then fix the 'L' angles / Slotted 'C' channels with nuts. 2 M distance is maintained between the supports to avoid the sagging of trays and ladders. 8 (Other Mechanical Stresses (AJ)) in that document provides requirements for cable support.
