

Safety Measures for Cable Tray Installation of Fiber Optic Cables

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and Handling

Workers should always wear safety glasses with side shields, gloves, and protective clothing to prevent injuries from fiber shards, sharp tray edges, or accidental contact with energized cables. Avoid touching eyes or face when handling fiber, and carefully collect and dispose of fiber scraps to prevent puncture injuries or contamination. Adequate lighting and a clean work area are essential to reduce hazards during installation.

Electrical Safety

Assume all cables may be live until verified otherwise. Lockout/tagout procedures should be followed to de-energize circuits before installation. Maintain proper grounding of cable trays to prevent electrical shock or arc flash incidents. Overloaded trays can trap heat, increasing insulation stress and fire risk, so ensure cables are distributed according to manufacturer load ratings and NEC guidelines.
