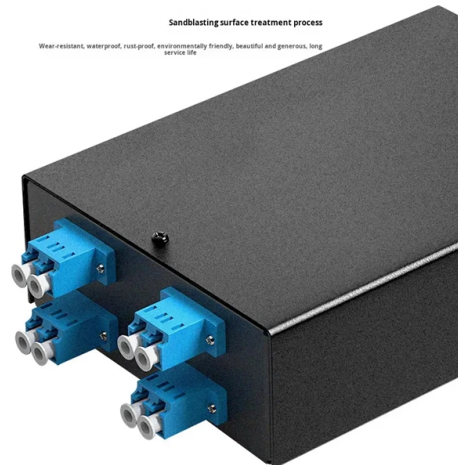


Sealing off the area below the distribution box



Article Overview

Sealing the bottom of a distribution box ensures a watertight, leak-free installation and protects the system from contamination or effluent leakage.

Materials and Seal Types

- Polylok D-Box Seals: Flexible rubber seals designed for multiple pipe sizes. They are inserted from the inside of the box and secured with a nut from the outside, creating a watertight connection around the pipe without cutting the seal unnecessarily .
- Twist-and-Lock Pipe Seals: Low-density polyethylene seals that rotatably lock at multiple points, often used in American Distribution Boxes. These seals can be combined with a bead of asphalt-based sealant for increased watertight integrity .
- Gaskets and Sealants: For electrical or control distribution boxes, seamless gaskets made from polyurethane or silicone foams can be applied along the bottom flange to prevent moisture and dust ingress .

Step-by-Step Installation for Wastewater Distribution Boxes

- Excavate and Prepare: Excavate the trench to the proper inlet and outlet elevations. Ensure the bottom is level and free of debris .
- Insert Seals: Place the selected seal into the bottom opening of the box. For Polylok seals, align the seal with the hole from the inside and screw the nut from the outside. For twist-and-lock seals, insert and rotate to lock at all designated points .
