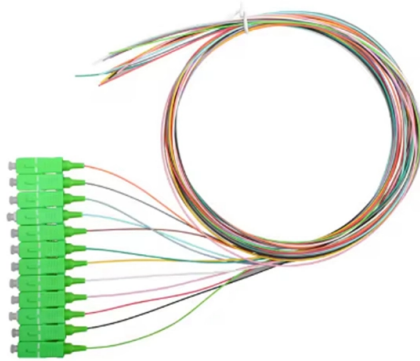

5. Types of Protective Relays: Protective relays are categorized by their mechanism (electromagnetic, static, mechanical) and function. Secondary circuit definition: all low-voltage circuits such as measurement circuits, relay protection circuits, switch control and signal circuits, operating power circuits, electrical blocking circuits of circuit breakers and isolating switches. Core idea: A relay uses one electrical signal to switch, isolate, interlock, alarm, or command another circuit. A vacuum circuit breaker's main contacts might withstand 25 kA short-circuit current perfectly—yet the installation fails commissioning because the control wiring introduces.
