A secondary distribution box connection switch manages power flow from the primary distribution system to localized loads, often using circuit breakers or solid-state power controllers for protection and control.

Function and Role

A secondary distribution box (SDB), also called a sub-distribution box, serves as an intermediary between the primary distribution cabinet and tertiary distribution points, such as individual units or equipment . It typically handles three-phase electricity and distributes power to multiple circuits within a building, floor, or specific area. The connection switch within the SDB allows operators to isolate, control, and protect the downstream circuits.

Types of Connection Switches

- Mechanical Switches and Circuit Breakers
- Traditional SDBs use large three-phase circuit breakers or isolating switches to connect or disconnect power from the primary source .
- These switches provide overcurrent protection and allow manual or automatic disconnection during maintenance or fault conditions.
- Solid-State Power Controllers (SSPCs)
- Modern SDBs may use modular semiconductor switches (SSPCs) to control loads electronically .
