

Should I use a router or fiber optic cable at home

Yes, a router is typically required to distribute fiber internet throughout your home, even though the Optical Network Terminal (ONT) converts the fiber signal.

Role of the ONT

Fiber optic internet delivers data as light pulses, which cannot be directly used by standard home devices. The Optical Network Terminal (ONT), provided by your ISP, converts the incoming fiber signal into electrical signals that can be transmitted over Ethernet to a router or gateway. The ONT is essential, but it does not provide Wi-Fi or manage multiple devices on your home network.

Why a Router is Needed

A router is required to:

- Distribute the internet connection to multiple devices via Wi-Fi or Ethernet.
- Manage network traffic and assign IP addresses through DHCP.
- Provide security features like firewalls and parental controls.
- Support high-speed connections to fully utilize fiber internet, especially for plans exceeding 1 Gbps. You can use your own router as long as it has a Gigabit Ethernet WAN port and supports the speed tier of your fiber plan. Routers designed for DSL or cable connections will not work with fiber.
