A lot of N-Trons I'm familiar with require a min operating distance of 2 km but wondering if there are others out there that support short runs?

Typically any optic (sfp) that is rated for 10km will work for. Single-mode fiber for short distances e.g. < 1 km : r/FiberOptics

If you are using SFPs for network switches most of the time the short haul optics can do 0-10km safely. It's the medium/long haul optics 40km or 80km where short runs can be dangerous to the RX side.
