

Size of circuit breaker in distribution box

Circuit breakers in a distribution box vary in size depending on type, number of poles, and current rating, with standard MCBs typically 18mm per pole.

Standard Breaker Dimensions

- MCBs (Miniature Circuit Breakers): Most commonly used in residential and light commercial panels, MCBs follow a modular DIN rail width of 18mm per pole. For example, a 1-pole MCB is 18mm wide, a 2-pole MCB is 36mm, and a 4-pole MCB is 72mm. High-current MCBs may have wider modules, such as 27mm per pole, to accommodate higher rated currents like 80A, 100A, or 125A .
- RCBOs (Residual Current Breaker with Overcurrent protection): These can be 18mm or 36mm per pole, depending on design and manufacturer .
- MCCBs (Molded Case Circuit Breakers): Unlike MCBs, MCCBs do not have a fixed modular width. Their size depends on frame size, rated current, breaking capacity, function, and number of poles. MCCBs are typically used for higher current applications in commercial or industrial settings .

Current Ratings and Selection

The physical size of a breaker is often linked to its current rating. Higher-rated breakers require larger internal structures to handle heat dissipation and ensure safe operation. For example, residential MCBs usually range from 6A to 63A, while MCCBs can handle hundreds of amperes . When selecting a breaker, it is important to match the breaker rating to the load it protects. Electrical codes, such as NEC or IEC standards, recommend leaving room for future expansion and ensuring the breaker is not overloaded .
