

Size of copper wire in the distribution box



Article Overview

Copper wire diameters in distribution boxes vary by AWG size, typically ranging from 1.63 mm (#14 AWG) to over 11.7 mm (#4/0 AWG) for residential and commercial circuits.

Standard Wire Sizes

Copper wires are commonly sized using the American Wire Gauge (AWG) system. Typical household distribution circuits use:

- #14 AWG: ~1.63–1.84 mm diameter, rated for 15 A circuits
 - #12 AWG: ~2.05 mm diameter, rated for 20 A circuits
 - #10 AWG: ~2.59 mm diameter, rated for 30 A circuits
 - #8 AWG: ~3.26 mm diameter, rated for 40–50 A circuits
 - #6 AWG: ~4.11 mm diameter, rated for 55–65 A circuits
- Larger service entrance or feeder wires can go up to #4/0 AWG, with diameters exceeding 11 mm, depending on current requirements and insulation type .

Solid vs. Stranded Wire

- Solid wire: The diameter corresponds directly to the conductor size.
- Stranded wire: The effective diameter is 5–15% larger than a solid wire of the same AWG due to the multiple strands and lay factor . For example, a 10 mm² solid copper conductor has a diameter of ~3.57 mm, while a stranded version may measure ~4.1 mm depending on strand count and arrangement.
