A small-to-small fiber optic patch cord, such as SC-to-SC, is a short fiber cable with connectors on both ends used to connect devices in optical networks, providing low-loss, high-speed data transmission.

Overview

A fiber optic patch cord (also called a fiber jumper) is a terminated fiber assembly with connectors on both ends, designed to interconnect devices like switches, servers, or optical distribution frames. The term "small-to-small" typically refers to small form factor connectors such as SC-to-SC, LC-to-LC, or similar, where both ends use the same connector type for compatibility and minimal signal loss .

Construction and Features

- **Fiber Type:** Single-mode (OS1/OS2) for long-distance, high-speed transmission, or multimode (OM1-OM5) for shorter distances .
- **Core and Cladding:** The optical fiber has a glass core and cladding where light travels, surrounded by a protective buffer and outer jacket .
- **Bend-Insensitive Design:** Many modern patch cords use G.657A1/A2 bend-insensitive fiber, allowing tight bends without significant signal loss, ideal for high-density or constrained spaces .
- **Strength Members:** Kevlar (aramid yarn) is often included under the jacket to enhance durability and prevent breakage during handling .
