

Sockets placed in cable trays



Article Overview

Directly placing sockets inside cable trays is generally not recommended; instead, sockets should be mounted adjacent to or supported by the tray system while maintaining safety and accessibility.

Key Considerations

Cable tray purpose: Cable trays are designed to support and route electrical cables in an organized manner, providing mechanical protection, ventilation, and easy access for maintenance . They are not intended to serve as enclosures for live electrical devices like sockets . **Safety and standards:** Cable trays are governed by standards such as BS EN 61537 and BS 6946, which specify that trays are for cable support, not for mounting electrical outlets or supporting personnel . Placing sockets directly in trays can create risks of overheating, short circuits, or mechanical damage to both the cables and the devices. **Practical alternatives:**

- **Adjacent mounting:** Sockets can be installed on walls, panels, or brackets near the cable tray, with short flexible conduits or cable drops connecting the tray cables to the socket .
- **Tray-mounted enclosures:** For instrumentation or control applications, small junction boxes or enclosures can be attached to the tray to house sockets or connectors, ensuring protection from mechanical damage and environmental factors .
- **Ventilation and heat management:** If sockets are near high-current cables, ensure adequate spacing and ventilation to prevent heat buildup, especially in solid-bottom or enclosed trays .
