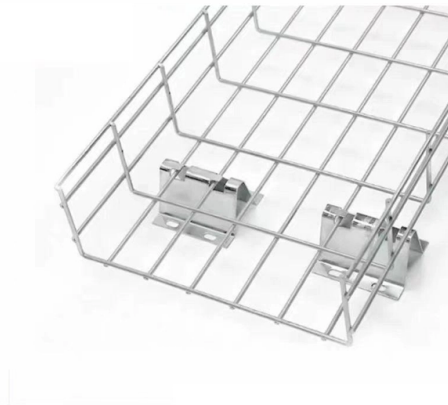


Spacing between the two distribution boxes



Article Overview

When distributing only two boxes, the spacing between them is fixed and cannot be automatically adjusted by distribution tools; distribution works best with three or more objects.

Distribution in Design Software

PowerPoint: Distribution tools like Distribute Horizontally or Distribute Vertically calculate equal spacing between objects based on the first and last object in a selection. However, with only two objects, PowerPoint does not adjust spacing because the distance between them is already defined. To control spacing manually, you must move one of the boxes or use guides to set the desired gap between them. Distribution requires at least three objects to create equal gaps automatically .

Photoshop: Similarly, Photoshop's Distribute Layers feature spaces multiple layers evenly based on edges or centers. With only two layers, the spacing is already determined, so the distribute command has no effect. You can manually adjust the gap or use alignment guides to maintain consistent spacing .

CSS (Web Design): In CSS, properties like justify-content: space-between or space-around in a flex container distribute extra space among multiple items. With only two items, space-between places one item at the start and the other at the end of the container, creating a fixed gap equal to the remaining space. space-around or space-evenly can adjust spacing more symmetrically, but the gap is still determined by the container size and cannot be dynamically calculated between just two elements without additional CSS or JavaScript .
