

Stacking of 2-fiber 24-electrical switches



Overview

In general, it is best to connect Stack Port 2 on one switch to Stack Port 1 on the switch with the next higher slot number. Although you can connect the switches in any order, connecting them as shown in these examples will produce better predictability and easier software. You should connect the switches with a StackWise cable and power them on. If you power on one before the other it will become the primary switch. Once both have been powered on you should configure one of the switches as the primary switch using "switch {switch number} priority {priority}" where. Switch stacking is a technology that connects multiple physical switches into a single logical unit. Stackable switches improve network scalability, reliability, and flexibility by increasing bandwidth and simplifying device management. At times there will be nobody using. Connecting switches can be achieved through two common methods: cascading and stacking.
