

Standard configuration parameters of a three-level distribution box



Article Overview

A three-level distribution box uses a hierarchical arrangement of ACB, MCCB, and MCB with rated currents, tripping curves, and leakage protection tailored to each distribution level.

Overview of Three-Level Distribution

A three-level distribution system divides power distribution into primary, secondary, and tertiary levels to ensure selective protection, reliability, and safety :

- First-Level Distribution Box (Main Distribution Box)
- Purpose: Receives power from the source and distributes it to second-level boxes.
- Equipment: Air Circuit Breaker (ACB), main leakage protector, voltmeter, ammeter.
- ACB Parameters:
- Rated current: 1.2–1.5 times the transformer capacity.
- Short-time delay: 0.1–0.5 s for selective coordination.
- Short-circuit breaking capacity: greater than the maximum short-circuit current at the installation point.
- Installation: High, dry, ventilated location for centralized monitoring .
- Second-Level Distribution Box (Sub-Distribution Box)
- Purpose: Distributes power from the first-level box to third-level boxes or large equipment.
