

Standard primary wiring for capacitor bank



Article Overview

Capacitor banks are typically wired in parallel to the power system, with protective fuses, discharge resistors, and switches, using either star (wye) or delta configurations depending on voltage and application.

Basic Wiring Components

A standard capacitor bank includes the following primary components:

- Capacitors: The main energy storage units, connected in parallel to supply reactive power and improve power factor .
- Fuses: Protect individual capacitors from overcurrent or short circuits .
- Discharge Resistors: Connected across each capacitor to safely discharge stored energy when the bank is de-energized, preventing shock hazards .
- Switches/Contactors: Control the connection of the capacitor bank to the power system, allowing for automated or manual switching .
- Control and Protection Devices: Relays, controllers, or monitoring systems detect unbalance, overvoltage, or faults to prevent damage .

Connection Configurations

Star (Wye) Connection

- Each capacitor is connected between a phase and neutral.
- Provides phase-to-neutral voltage across each capacitor.
