

Standards for Galvanized Pipes Used in Optical Cables



Article Overview

Galvanized pipes used for optical cables must provide mechanical protection, corrosion resistance, proper conduit sizing, and compliance with fiber optic installation standards.

Material and Corrosion Resistance

Galvanized pipes must be hot-dip or electro-galvanized steel to resist corrosion, especially in underground or outdoor environments. The zinc coating protects the steel from moisture and soil chemicals, ensuring long-term durability for fiber optic installations . Pipes should meet relevant ASTM or ISO standards for galvanized steel conduits.

Conduit Sizing and Cable Protection

The internal diameter of the galvanized pipe must accommodate the fiber optic cable without exceeding the maximum pulling tension or minimum bend radius specified by the cable manufacturer . For example, Corning recommends calculating the working bend radius as 15 times the cable diameter during installation, and pull wheels or rollers should be at least twice this radius . Pipes should allow for future cable additions, often requiring innerducts or pre-installed liners to facilitate cable pulling .
