

Standards for Requirements of Optical Cable Laying in Ducts



Article Overview

Optical cables in ducts should be installed following ITU-T, IEC, and FOA standards, ensuring proper tension, bend radius, duct filling, and protection to maintain performance and durability.

Key Installation Standards

International Standards: Optical fiber cables installed in ducts should comply with ITU-T L.100, ITU-T G.65x series, and IEC 60794-3-11 standards, which define mechanical, environmental, and optical performance requirements, including tensile strength, bending, crush resistance, and water-blocking properties . **FOA Guidelines:** The Fiber Optic Association emphasizes proper handling, supervision, and adherence to manufacturer specifications, including cable reception, manipulation, and splicing, to prevent damage during installation .

Mechanical Considerations

- **Pulling Tension:** Maximum pulling tension must not exceed the cable's rated limit, typically around 600 lbf (2,700 N) for stranded loose tube or ribbon cables, but always refer to the specific cable datasheet .
- **Bend Radius:** Maintain a minimum bend radius during installation, often 15 times the cable diameter for working bends, and double that for pull wheels or rollers .
- **Cable Reserves:** Leave cable slack in figure-eight or circular loops to prevent kinking and allow future maintenance .
