

Technical routes of fiber optic communication



Overview

Modern fiber-optic communication systems generally include optical transmitters that convert electrical signals into optical signals, optical fiber cables to carry the signal, optical amplifiers, and optical receivers to convert the signal back into an electrical signal. Fiber-optic communication is a form of optical communication for transmitting information from one place to another by sending pulses of infrared or visible light through an optical fiber. The light is a form of carrier wave that is modulated to carry information. However, it is not always easy to find out what has been covered, and where it can be found. Optical fiber wave guides- Introduction, Ray theory transmission, Total Internal Reflection: Attenuation, Absorption, Scattering and Bending losses, Core and Cladding losses.
