Overview

After the initial cut for the cased pelt, follow these guidelines for skinning out the tail. For fur-tailed furbearers, the tail is split, skinned out, and. Skinning a squirrel using the tail method is a practical and efficient technique favored by hunters and trappers for its simplicity and effectiveness. This method involves gripping the squirrel's tail firmly and using it as a handle to pull the skin off in one smooth motion, starting from the base. The skin is easier to remove when the animal is fresh and damage to the pelt is less likely. There are two recognized ways of skinning animals called "cased" and "open. " All furbearers except beaver and badgers are prepared cased. ". When you have a furbearer that you've trapped and dispatched lying on the ground in front of you, you either skin it on the spot or take it home to skin later. Case skinning, the first step is to make a cut entirely. Pulls tail skin off easy.

Care of Pelts

Once you've worked the pelt off the hind legs you'll have the tail to contend with. To remove the tail bone make a cut from the anus up the bottom side of the tail to the end. Then peel and work the pelt free
