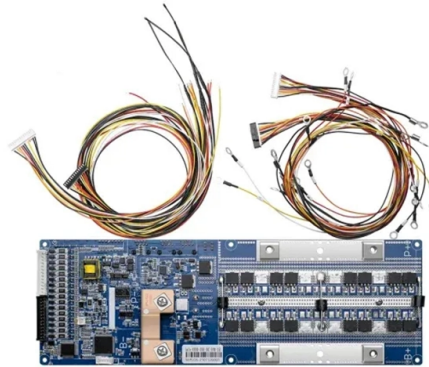


Termination of backbone optical cables

Overview of Fiber Termination

Fiber optic termination is the process of preparing the end of a fiber optic cable so it can connect to another fiber, network equipment, or patch panel with minimal signal loss and high reliability. Backbone cables, which carry high-capacity traffic over long distances, require precise termination to maintain signal integrity and network performance.

Primary Termination Methods

1. Fusion Splicing Fusion splicing is the most reliable method for backbone cables. It permanently joins two fibers end-to-end using an electric arc, creating a nearly seamless optical path. Key features include:

- Low insertion loss: Typically 0.01–0.1 dB, ideal for long-haul and high-bandwidth networks.
- High durability: Permanent connection resistant to environmental stress.
- Equipment required: Fusion splicer, precision cleaver, fiber stripper, and cleaning tools.
