It enables precise alignment of multiple fibers (8, 12, 24, or more) within a single interface, significantly increasing cabling density compared to traditional single-fiber connectors. 16-core MT ferrule: used in. On 40G-SR optics running in 40Gbps mode (not 4x10G breakout mode), 4 lanes of 10Gbps ethernet signals are transmitted on 4 fibers in each direction.
