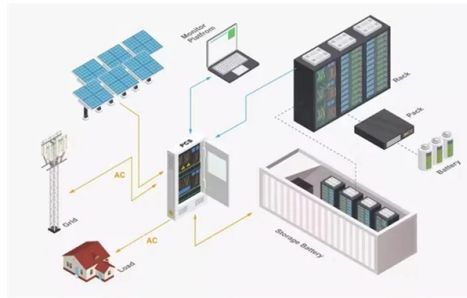


The Role of Monitoring Access Layer Switches

Overview of Access Layer Switches

Access layer switches operate at the network edge, connecting end-user devices such as computers, IP phones, printers, and wireless access points to the broader network infrastructure . They are typically Layer 2 switches, forwarding traffic based on MAC addresses, though Layer 3 switches can also be used to route traffic between VLANs and subnets . These switches often support VLANs, Power over Ethernet (PoE), and security features to manage and segregate traffic efficiently .
