Overview

FTTH Butterfly Optic Cables, also known as flat drop fiber cables, feature a compact flat profile with optical fibers placed at the center and reinforced by parallel strength members on both sides. The outer sheath is typically LSZH or PVC, optimized for indoor and outdoor. The utility model discloses a butterfly-shaped optical cable, including cable core and inner sheath, the inner sheath cross-section is the equilateral triangle at fillet, with the focus of inner sheath is the centre of a circle the inside circular cavity that is equipped with of inner sheath, the. The invention provides a bending-resistant and damage-resistant butterfly-shaped optical cable which comprises a butterfly-shaped outer protective sleeve 1, wherein an optical fiber 3 is arranged in the middle of the outer protective sleeve, a reinforcing core material 4 is respectively arranged at. The invention provides a test method and a test device for evaluating L-direction bending performance of a long axis of a butterfly-shaped optical cable, which comprise the following steps: s1, preprocessing, namely rewinding a butterfly-shaped optical cable to be. An additional steel wire strength member is attached to the outer side, followed by extrusion with black low smoke.
