Protective grounding of a distribution box ensures safety by providing a low-resistance path for fault currents, stabilizing voltages, and preventing electric shock or equipment damage.

Purpose of Protective Grounding

Protective grounding in distribution boxes is essential to:

- Protect personnel from electric shock by ensuring exposed metal parts are at earth potential.
- Safeguard equipment by providing a reliable path for fault currents, allowing circuit breakers to trip promptly.
- Stabilize system voltages during transient events such as lightning strikes or switching surges.
- Maintain operational integrity of electrical systems under normal and fault conditions .

Grounding Components and Connections

- Terminal Blocks: All protective earth (PE) wires should be connected to a dedicated terminal block inside the distribution box. This ensures a secure, low-resistance path and prevents loose wire splices or direct enclosure grounding faults .
