- **Clearance:** NEC guidelines require at least 30 inches of width and 3 feet of front workspace clearance to ensure safe operation and maintenance.
- **Ventilation and Safety:** The area should be dry, well-ventilated, and free from heat or moisture sources. Proper grounding and secure wiring are essential to prevent electrical hazards.
- **Open vs. Concealed Installation:** Surface-mounted boxes are easier to access, while recessed boxes inside walls improve aesthetics but may be harder to service.
