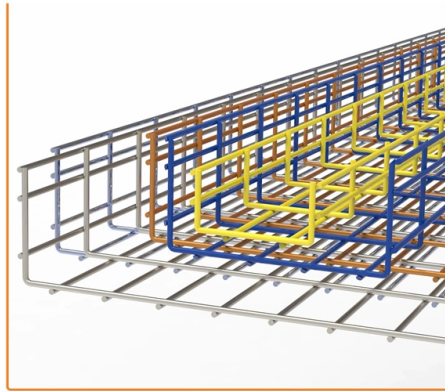

Overview

Live (L) Wire Connection: In a distribution box setup, the incoming live wire (also known as phase or hot wire, denoted as L or Line) connects to the line terminal of the circuit breaker. This serves as the primary source of electrical energy from the mains supply. The Distribution box system diagram mainly includes the following parts:

Incoming line part: Displays the incoming line source of the distribution box, which may be a single-line incoming line or multiple-line incoming lines (such as normal power supply and backup power supply), and marks the.
