A yellow or amber light might indicate that the device is in a warning or caution state, such as when it's booting up or when there's a problem with the connection. The Fibre Connection Box on your wall (the engineers will call this the Optical Network Terminator or ONT) is where the Fibre comes into your home. Make sure all cable are secure/snug and haven't come loose. Power down for 15mins then power back on and wait 3mins for the lights to settle Power connector has come loose. Plug a lamp into the same plug socket and see if it turns on. Are the lights behaving strangely?

If you're seeing some really unusual behaviour such as the lights for empty ports flashing, have there been recent lightning storms in your area?
