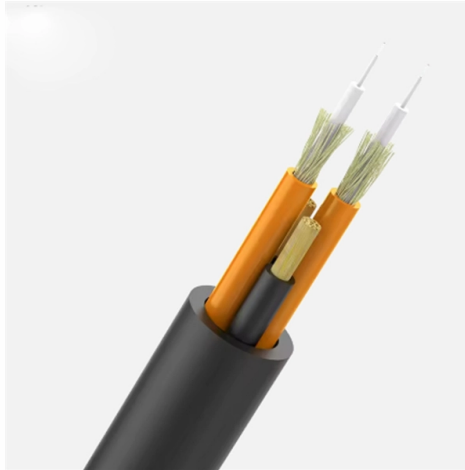


The role of the terminal box in a linear heat sensor



Article Overview

A terminal box (junction box) for linear heat sensors provides a secure, weatherproof connection point for sensor cables, enabling continuity monitoring, cable protection, and integration with control systems.

Purpose and Function

A terminal box, also called a junction box, is used to connect, protect, and terminate linear heat detection cables. It allows multiple cable lines to join safely, provides strain relief, and ensures the system can monitor for faults such as open or short circuits. Terminal boxes are often used in conjunction with end-of-line (EOL) devices to maintain continuity monitoring and signal integrity in both analogue and digital systems .

Types and Materials

- **Material:** Terminal boxes are available in stainless steel, fiberglass, or non-metallic moisture-proof materials, depending on environmental requirements .
- **IP Ratings:** Common ratings include IP65, IP66, and IP67, providing protection against dust, water, and harsh conditions .
- **Analogue vs Digital:** Analogue systems can monitor both open and closed circuit faults, while digital systems typically monitor open circuit faults only .
