Common Locations

- Indoor: Basements, utility rooms, garages, hallways, or closets (excluding clothing closets) are typical indoor locations. Panels may also be hidden behind appliances or in pantries, but must remain accessible for safety and maintenance purposes .
- Outdoor: Panels can be mounted on exterior walls near the electric meter, often on the side or rear of the house. Outdoor panels must be weatherproof and corrosion-resistant .

Identification

Look for a rectangular metal box, usually gray or black, with a hinged door or removable cover. Sizes typically range from 14-20 inches wide and 20-40 inches tall. The main breaker is the largest switch, controlling power to the entire home, while smaller circuit breakers manage individual circuits .

Safety and Clearance Requirements

- Front clearance: Minimum 3 feet of clear space in front of the panel.
- Side clearance: At least 30 inches on both sides.
