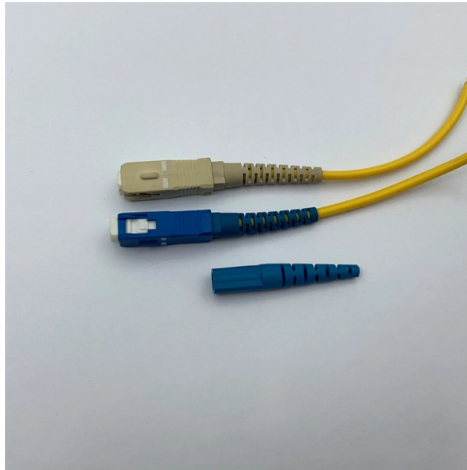


Thickness of cable tray hooks



Article Overview

Cable tray hooks typically have a thickness ranging from 2 mm to 5 mm, depending on the tray type, load requirements, and material used.

General Guidelines

The thickness of cable tray hooks is closely related to the material strength, load capacity, and type of cable tray being supported. Hooks are usually made from steel, stainless steel, or aluminum, and their thickness must ensure that the tray remains securely suspended without bending or deformation under the weight of cables .

- Light-duty trays (e.g., wire mesh or channel trays) often use hooks with a thickness of 2–3 mm, sufficient for supporting small bundles of control or data cables .
- Medium-duty trays (e.g., perforated trays) generally require hooks of 3–4 mm thickness to handle moderate cable loads and maintain structural stability .
- Heavy-duty trays (e.g., ladder trays for power cables) may need hooks 4–5 mm thick or more, especially when supporting long spans or high cable density .

Standards and Considerations

- IEC 61537 specifies mechanical strength requirements for cable trays and their support systems, ensuring that hooks and brackets can withstand the expected load without failure .
- NEC/NEMA guidelines also influence hook sizing, emphasizing that the support system must safely carry the total cable weight plus a safety margin .
- Material choice affects thickness: stainless steel hooks may be slightly thinner than carbon steel hooks for the same load due to higher tensile strength .
