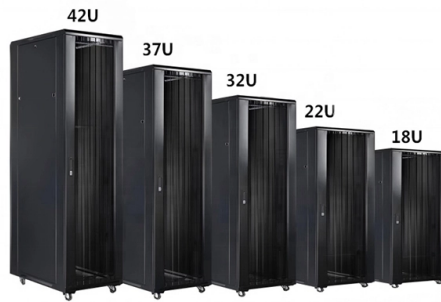

Ladder trays are ideal for heavy-duty cables over long distances and are widely used in industrial settings due to their durability and ease of cable access for installation and maintenance. They are also code-compliant for single conductor and Type MV cables.

Trough (Ventilated) Type Cable Tray

A trough-type cable tray features a continuous or partially ventilated bottom with solid side rails, providing moderate structural strength and good cable support. It offers a balance between the open ventilation of ladder trays and the protection of solid-bottom trays. Trough trays are suitable for installations where cable protection is needed without sacrificing airflow, making them common in commercial and industrial applications where moderate cable loads are present.
