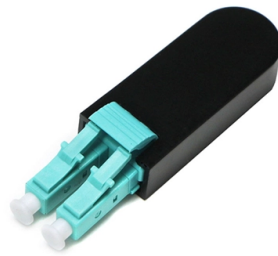


Vertical installation distance of cable tray

Vertical Runs: For vertical cable runs within trays, cables should be secured at the top and every 1. All bends must be securely fastened. Cable Types: Only use. maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is ect the minimum bend ra-dius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray cont d for instrumentation and control applications that require. Spacing Standards:

Electrical (power) and instrumentation (signal/control) cable trays should maintain a minimum vertical and horizontal distance. Industry standards often recommend at least 300mm (12 inches) of spacing between power and control trays to minimize EMI. Long Span trays are typically supported anywhere from 14 to 20-foot intervals, with 20 -feet being the most popular.
