Global Fiber Deployment Overview

Developed countries have invested heavily in fiber optic networks to support high-speed internet, enterprise connectivity, and future digital services. According to the Fiber Development Index (FDI) 2024, Singapore leads globally with maximum scores in six out of nine metrics, followed by the UAE, Qatar, South Korea, Japan, Denmark, Spain, and the United States, which ranks 28th among North American territories in fiber development . These metrics include FTTH coverage, fiber-to-business penetration, mobile cell-site fiber, advanced WDM technology, and network performance indicators such as median download/upload speeds, latency, and jitter .
