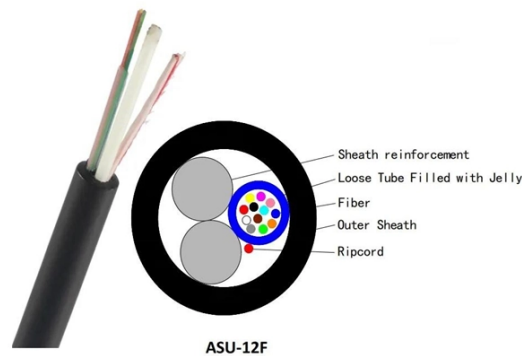


What are the fire protection requirements for cable tray supports



Article Overview

Cable tray supports must be fire-resistant, securely mounted, and properly spaced to prevent collapse and maintain cable integrity during a fire.

Fire-Resistant Support Materials

Cable tray supports should be made from materials that will not fail under fire conditions, such as steel, galvanized steel, or other fire-rated metals. Fire-resistant supports ensure that the cable system remains intact and functional during a fire, preventing premature collapse and maintaining critical power or communication lines. For fire-rated cables, the supports themselves must also be fire-resistant to match the cable's rating.

Support Spacing and Mechanical Stability

Supports must be installed at appropriate intervals to prevent undue mechanical strain on the cables. The spacing depends on cable type, diameter, and weight, following guidance such as the IET Selection and Erection Guidance Notes or NEC Article 392. Supports should maintain the tray level, plumb, and securely mounted, with horizontal deviation ≤ 2 mm per meter and vertical deviation ≤ 3 mm per meter. Proper support spacing also ensures that the tray does not collapse during a fire, which is critical for safety and system reliability.
