Overview of ODN

The Optical Distribution Network (ODN) is the passive segment of a Passive Optical Network (PON) that connects the Optical Line Terminal (OLT) at the service provider's central office to multiple Optical Network Units (ONUs) or Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) at the customer premises. The ODN is entirely passive, meaning it does not require electrical power, which reduces operational costs and increases reliability. It typically spans distances of 20–30 km and supports point-to-multipoint topologies, allowing a single fiber from the OLT to serve multiple endpoints through passive devices .

Key Passive Optical Devices

- Optical Splitters
- Splitters are the most critical passive devices in the ODN. They divide a single optical signal from the OLT into multiple signals to serve several ONUs/ONTs.
- Common split ratios include 1:2, 1:4, 1:8, 1:16, 1:32, and 1:64, depending on network design and subscriber density.
- Splitters are purely passive and do not require power, ensuring low maintenance and high reliability .
