Purpose and Function

The equipment room, also known as the main cross-connect (MXC) or central equipment room, serves as the hub for all fiber optic and network connections within a building or campus. It connects the building to external networks through a service entrance and distributes signals to other equipment rooms or telecommunications rooms (TRs) via backbone cabling. This centralized approach supports high-speed data transmission, reduces intermediate electronics, and can eliminate the need for multiple telecom closets in a fiber-to-the-desk (FTTD) architecture.
