

What cables should be installed in a fire-fighting power cable tray



Article Overview

Fire-fighting power cable trays should contain fire-resistant power and control cables compliant with BS8519, designed to maintain circuit integrity for 30, 60, or 120 minutes under fire conditions.

Recommended Cable Types

BS8519-compliant cables are the primary choice for fire-fighting power cable trays. These include:

- Fire-resistant power cables: Single-core or multi-core cables designed to maintain electrical supply to critical systems during fire events, ensuring operational continuity for life safety and firefighting equipment .
- Control cables: Used for auxiliary control circuits in fire-fighting systems, including sprinkler systems, smoke barriers, and evacuation lifts .
- Enhanced fire-resistant cables (PH120): Required in complex or high-rise buildings, unsprinklered structures, or where a two-hour operational period is mandated .
- Steel wire armoured (SWA) fire performance cables: Provide additional mechanical protection against impact and water jets, suitable for exposed or high-risk areas .

Fire Survival Times

Cables are classified by fire survival times to ensure circuit integrity:

- 30 minutes (PH30): Suitable for standard buildings and less critical circuits.
