

What color is a 12-core optical cable

The 12th core of a 12-core optical fiber cable is Aqua (light blue).

According to the TIA-598-C standard, which is widely used for fiber optic color coding, the standard 12-color sequence for individual fibers in a cable is: 1-Blue, 2-Orange, 3-Green, 4-Brown, 5-Slate (Gray), 6-White, 7-Red, 8-Black, 9-Yellow, 10-Violet, 11-Rose (Pink), and 12-Aqua (Light Blue) .
