

What connector should I use for the optical port on the switch

For most modern SFP-based optical ports on switches, an LC connector is typically used, paired with the appropriate fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode) according to the SFP module specifications.

Understanding SFP Ports and Optical Modules

Switches with optical ports usually feature SFP (Small Form-Factor Pluggable) slots, which can accept either fiber or copper modules depending on your network needs . The type of connector you use depends on the SFP module installed:

- Fiber SFP modules: Require fiber optic cables with connectors such as LC, SC, or ST.
- Copper SFP modules: Use standard RJ45 Ethernet cables for short-distance connections .

Common Fiber Connectors

- LC (Lucent Connector): Most widely used in modern SFP modules; compact, duplex design for send/receive fibers; ideal for both single-mode and multi-mode fiber .
- SC (Subscriber Connector): Larger, push-pull design; less common in new SFP setups.
- ST (Straight Tip): Bayonet-style connector; mostly found in older networks .
