Basic Function of a Beam Splitter

A beam splitter is an optical device that splits an incident light beam into two separate beams, typically by partial reflection and partial transmission at a coated surface or interface . The split beams can then be directed along different paths for analysis, measurement, or imaging. Beam splitters are used in interferometers, spectrometers, laser systems, and imaging devices to enable simultaneous observation or manipulation of light along multiple paths .

Role of the Moving Beam Splitter

In systems like Fourier-transform infrared (FTIR) spectroscopy or Michelson interferometers, one of the split beams is reflected off a moving mirror or a moving beam splitter, while the other beam reflects off a fixed mirror . The motion of the beam splitter changes the optical path length of one beam relative to the other. When the beams recombine, this path difference produces interference patterns that encode information about the light's wavelength, intensity, or phase . The moving beam splitter allows the system to:

- Modulate the interference signal continuously, enabling high-resolution spectral measurements in FTIR systems .
- Measure precise distances or changes in optical path length, which is essential in metrology and optical sensing.
