

What does z represent in a high-voltage distribution box

In a high-voltage distribution box, "Z" represents the transformer's impedance, usually expressed as a percentage of rated voltage required to circulate full-load current through a short-circuited secondary.

Definition and Significance

The symbol "Z" or "Z%" on a transformer or distribution equipment indicates the impedance of the transformer, which combines the effects of winding resistance and magnetic flux leakage. It is expressed as a percentage of the rated primary voltage needed to drive the rated current through a shorted secondary winding. For example, a transformer with a 6% impedance requires 6% of its rated voltage to circulate full-load current if the secondary is short-circuited .

Practical Implications

- **Fault Current Limitation:** Z% directly controls the maximum short-circuit current the transformer can deliver. Lower Z% allows higher fault currents, while higher Z% limits fault currents, affecting protection device selection .
- **Voltage Drop:** It influences voltage sag under load. Transformers with higher Z% experience more voltage drop during heavy loads or motor starting .
- **Parallel Operation:** When multiple transformers operate in parallel, Z% ensures proper load sharing and prevents circulating currents that could damage equipment .
- **Protection Coordination:** Knowledge of Z% is essential for sizing circuit breakers, fuses, and relays to ensure safe operation during faults .
