Advantages of Fiber Optic Connections

They are less susceptible to electromagnetic interference (EMI), which ensures reliable data transmission in high-density data center environments. Fiber is ideal for server-to-server connections, switch uplinks, and external network connectivity, supporting applications like cloud computing, high-performance computing (HPC), and storage area networks (SANs) with minimal latency and signal degradation .

Types of Fiber Cables

- **Single-Mode Fiber (SMF):** Uses a single strand of glass fiber for long-distance, high-bandwidth transmission. Common types include OS1 and OS2, suitable for backbone connections and high-speed uplinks .
- **Multi-Mode Fiber (MMF):** Uses multiple strands of glass fiber for shorter distances within a data center. Subtypes include OM3, OM4, and OM5, optimized for high-speed intra-rack or inter-rack connections .
