Unlike standard broadband, leased lines are symmetrical, offering equal upload and download speeds, and are uncontended, meaning the bandwidth is reserved exclusively for the organization's traffic . They are ideal for applications requiring low latency and high reliability, such as VoIP, video conferencing, and real-time data transfer .
