A network cable tray is a support system designed to securely route, organize, and protect network and electrical cables in buildings or industrial facilities.

Definition and Purpose

A network cable tray is a structural framework used to hold and manage insulated electrical and data cables, including power, control, and communication lines, in a safe and organized manner (). Unlike traditional conduit systems that fully enclose cables, cable trays provide an open or partially open pathway, allowing for easier installation, maintenance, and future upgrades (). They prevent cables from lying loose, reducing the risk of physical damage, overheating, or interference ().

Components and Structure

Cable tray systems typically consist of:

- Straight Sections: Long, linear segments forming the main cable runs ().
- Fittings: Bends, tees, and risers that allow the tray to navigate corners, change elevation, or branch out ().
- Supports: Trapeze hangers, wall brackets, or ceiling mounts that anchor the tray to the building structure ().
- Covers: Optional protective covers to shield cables from dust, debris, or moisture ().
